Thank you for your interest in Windber Country Club Ladies League. This quick welcome guide has been prepared to provide you with an introduction and overview.

Weekly play opportunities:

9 Hole League

Format: Scramble

When: Tuesdays, May-October, 4:30PM meet, 5:00PM shot gun

Meeting Location: Pro Shop Porch

How to Sign Up: A sign-up sheet is posted outside the pro shop. Sign up by noon on Tuesday for that evening's play.

Optional Activities: Join other players for dinner after play. Menu orders are taken prior to play so your dinner is ready when you are.

With a scramble format, the 9-hole league is the perfect option for players of all skill levels wishing to join other members for a friendly night of play without a competitive vibe. This 2-hour commitment is an opportunity to get out and play each week while managing a busy schedule.

18 Hole League

Format: Various individual and team formats

When: Wednesdays, May-October, 8:45AM

Meeting Location: Ladies Locker Room

How to Sign Up: A sign-up sheet is posted outside the pro shop. Sign up by noon on Tuesday for the next day's play.

Note: Participants of in the 18 Hole League need to have an established handicap. Visit the pro shop for information.

Give it try and then decide! Play up to two 9 Hole and/or 18 Hole league rounds without joining. Anyone may take advantage of this opportunity. Once a decision has been made to join, a full WCC membership is required along with dues paid to the Windber Country Club Ladies League.

League Events:

Spring Meeting – April

This evening provides a welcome back after the long winter! Meet league leadership and members. Learn details about the upcoming year.

Ladies Fun Day – June

Ladies Fun Day is just that, an opportunity to invite your friends to join us for a day of play and fundraising for a great cause. The designated non-profit for this year is Friends of Flight 93, the fundraising organization that supports the Flight 93 National Memorial through financial and volunteer efforts. This is a great way to honor the 25th anniversary of the events of 9/11.

Helen Wheeling Orris Tournament – August

This event is a scramble format with dinner. All Windber Country Club ladies with an established handicap, regardless of membership status, may play in this FREE event.

Scramble & Pizza Party – August

Invite your member and non-member friends for a fun evening of 9-hole play followed by a complimentary pizza party.

Ladies Club Championship (includes a Senior Club Champ) – August

Annual Banquet, Awards and Recognitions – October

This evening provides a year end wrap up and thank you to all members. Enjoy dinner and skill award presentations (chip ins, birdies etc. as collected throughout the season.)

Quick Q&A:

What is the cost to participate?

The cost to participate is a total of \$30, whether play in the 9-Hole League, 18-Hole or both are desired. Payment is due by June 1st. The annual dues cover the August Scramble and Pizza Party and October Annual Banquet. Each week, players contribute \$4 which becomes prize money to be split among the top performing team(s).

I am a WCC Social Member, can I join the Ladies League?

You may take advantage of the offer to play without joining, twice per 9-Hole & 18-Hole Leagues. If you decide to join, a Windber Country Club full membership is necessary.

Who do I play with?

A monthly pairing team assigns the pairings for each week with a goal of providing an opportunity to play with various members.

Do I have to play every week?

While we would love to see you each week, you may play as little or often as you like. Simply sign up outside the pro shop by noon Tuesdays for either/both leagues' weekly play.

Do I have to have a handicap?

Having a handicap is encouraged as it provides the pairing committees with helpful information. A handicap is also required to play in the 18-hole league and some club tournaments. Stop by the pro shop to set up an account on the GHIN System, the USGA's golf handicap information network platform used by WCC.

What if I sign up to play and then need to cancel?

If it's too late to make a change to the sign-up sheet located outside the pro shop, simply call one of the members designated to create the month's pairings.

How do I join?

Sign up for play outside the pro shop by noon on Tuesdays. When you arrive to play, explain that you are considering joining. It's that easy.
